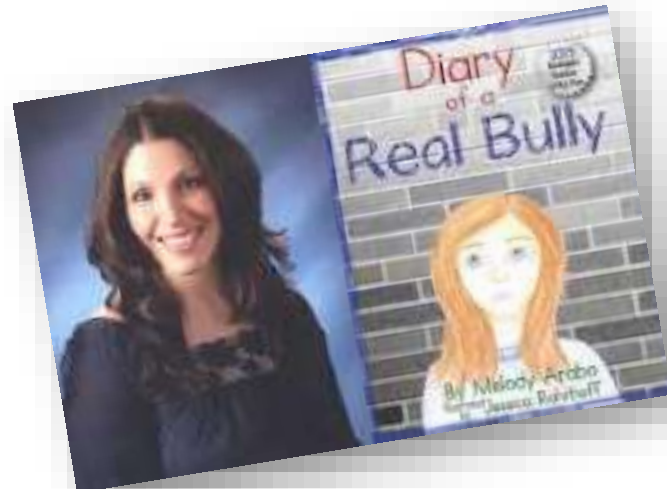

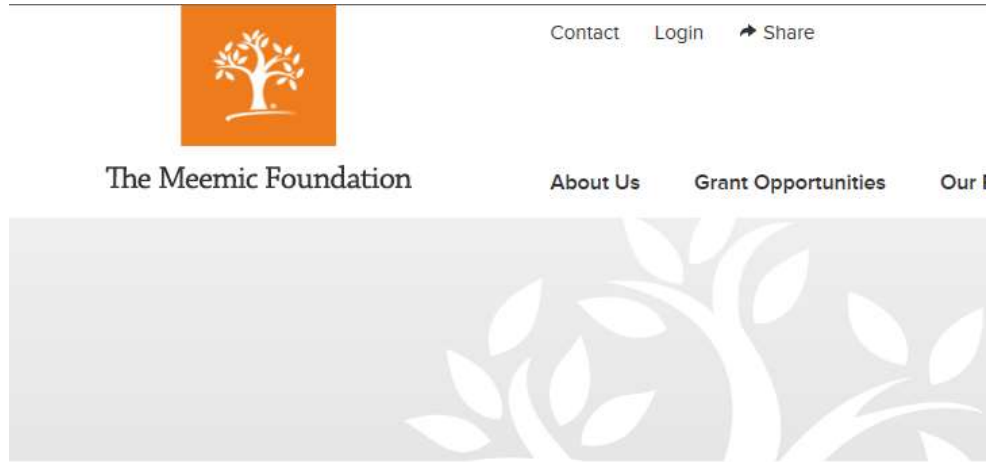

Choose Your Grant Type

Apply for a Traditional Quarterly Grant

Accepting applications for current quarterly grant round through September 30, 2015

- Grants available for a variety of programs including classroom projects, field trips, professional development for educators
- Apply for grants up to \$500 for this current quarterly grant round
- Recipients notified 45 days after end of quarter

Apply for a \$100 Book Fair Grant

Accepting applications August 24, 2015 through September 30, 2015

- \$100 grants available to use at Scholastic Book Fairs® in-school and online book fairs!
- Apply in minutes with short 3-question application.
- Recipients notified by October 15, 2015.

Progress is shown along the top of the screen.

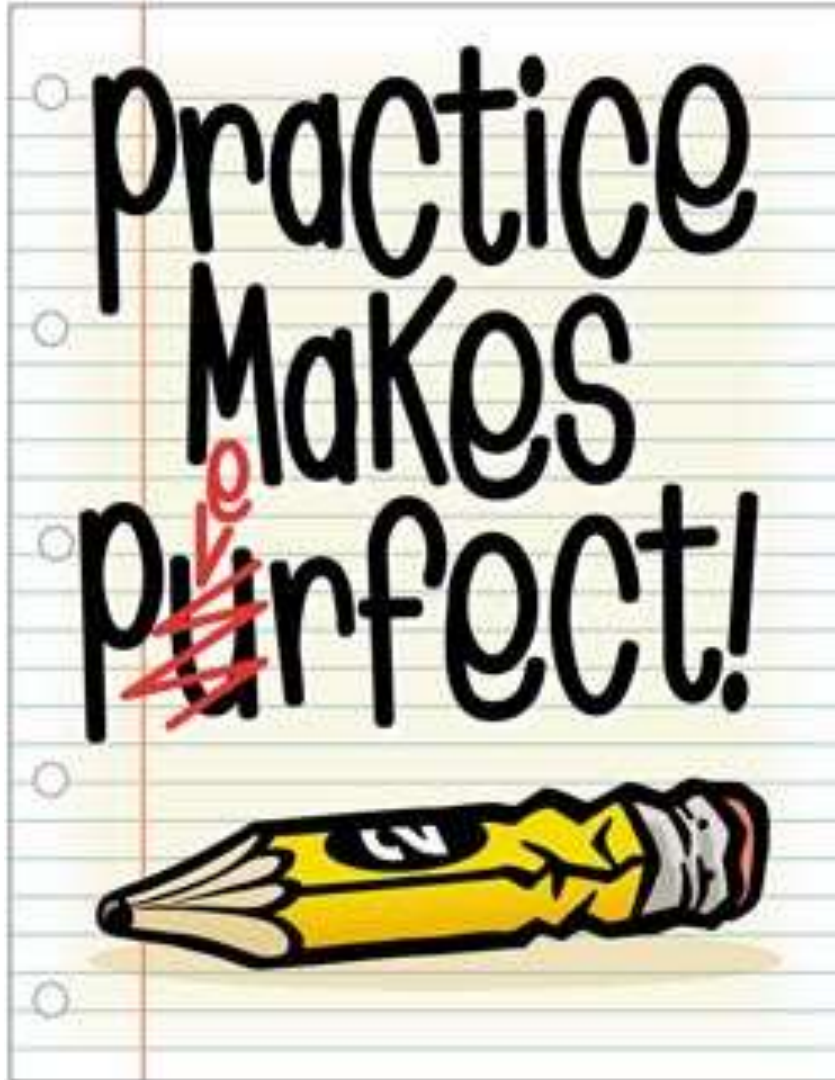
Each grouping of questions go together.
